Dahabiya Nile Cruise is a passenger boat used on the River Nile in Egypt. The term is normally used to describe a shallow-bottomed, barge-like vessel with two or more sails. The vessels have been around in one form or another for thousands of years, with similar craft being depicted on the walls of the tombs of Egyptian Pharaohs. Indeed, the name is thought to derive from the Arabic word for "gold" owing to similar gilded state barges used by the Muslim rulers of Egypt in the Middle Ages. During the 1920-1940's it was commonly used during those elegant days of the monarchy when aristocrats, pashas, emirs, sultans, and sophisticated travelers loved to cruise the Nile in style. Before the introduction of steamboats, the Dahabiya was the most normal way for travelers to ascend the Nile and even after that they remained popular amongst the wealthy. It took from two to three months to ascend the Nile under wind power and another month-and-ahalf to float back downstream, stopping at the great temples along the way. King Farouk, Churchill, Montgomery, and others settled in for the journey and a certain Lady Edwards even had a piano installed on her sailing vessel.

 - B. After that, you'll have some free time to explore the space on your own and connect with its energy.
 - C. If you feel called to meditate, you may do so quietly—either alone or with a partner/friend.
 - D. Please do not meditate as a group during regular visits, and always maintain silence (no chanting or sound).
- 2. To honor the deep spiritual experience of group meditation, we've arranged five special private visits—before opening hours and away from the public—where we can gather as a group for meditation and ceremonial work with logistics as per Ministry of antiquities
- 3. Regulations. The 4 private visits during the main tour:
 - 1. The Great Pyramid of King Cheops (Giza Plateau)
 - 2. The Sphinx (1-hour private access)
 - 3. Karnak Temple (Luxor) 1hour only
 - 4. The Temple of Isis (Aswan)

4. Important Guidelines According to Egyptian Antiquities Regulations

To ensure full compliance with the official antiquity regulations during private visits, please carefully follow the rules below:

1. Silence and Respect:

No loud noises, wired equipment, musical instruments, libations, meditation sessions, or ceremonies are permitted during private visits.

2. **Prohibited Substances:**

The use of oils, liquids (including blood, wine, or similar substances) is strictly forbidden inside the temples.

3. **Incense and Burning Materials:**

Burning incense or any similar substances in the temple or around the altars is not allowed.

4. Music and Audio Devices:

The use of music, loudspeakers, or any sound amplification devices is prohibited.

5. **Photography and Filming:**
