Day 1 Sun, 28th April. Arrival at Cairo Airport, Egypt. Dinner Included

Gnosis of Sakkara

- Overnight onboard the Dahabiya











Gnosis of Aswan & Philae Temple

Aswan is considered the Root Chakra. The main god of Aswan is Khnum, the ram-headed god — the god of creation who sits on the potter's wheel and forms and makes individuals out of clay. When visiting Aswan, many people experience what is described as "a new birth"

Our Journey

Here we are at the Root chakra, Philae Temple of the Goddess Isis (Love & Magic Goddess), here we will enjoy the link and connection with Isis in our visit and activate a deeper essence of our divine feminine Energy. Philae is the place where Isis found the heart of Osiris and then, buried it in a nearby island. Isis was an important figure in the ancient world because she was the enchantress, who resurrected Osiris and gave birth to their son Horus. This is the journey of calling home all your lost or dormant soul fragments, just as Osiris was rebuilt, (re-membered) returning to wholeness.

Dahabiya Nile Cruise: is a passenger boat used on the River Nile in Egypt. The term is normally used to describe a shallow-bottomed, barge-like vessel with two or more sails. The vessels have been around in one form or another for thousands of years, with similar craft being depicted on the walls of the tombs of Egyptian Pharaohs. Indeed, the name is thought to derive from the Arabic word for "gold" owing to similar gilded state barges used by the Muslim rulers of Egypt in the Middle Ages. During the 1920-1940's it was commonly used during those elegant days of the monarchy when aristocrats, pashas, emirs, sultans and sophisticated travellers loved to cruise the Nile in style. Before the introduction of steamboats, the Dahabiya was the most normal way for travellers to ascend the Nile and even after that they remained somewhat popular amongst the wealthy. It took from two to three months to ascend the Nile under wind power and another month-and-a-half to float back downstream, stopping at the great temples along the way. King Farouk, Churchill, Montgomery, Mark Twain and others settled in for the journey.

The Dahabiya's were popular amongst those who wished to enjoy Egypt at a leisurely pace, to drink in the landscapes and peruse the monuments and villages on the riverbanks. Those elegant days are revived with **Semi Luxury modern comforts and conveniences**. Spacious quarters include panoramic windows, a main salon, bar and sun deck. A skilled river captain and his crew are on board at all times. Meals will be taken on deck while you watch the timeless way of life along the banks of the Nile. The temptation to spend at least one night gazing at the stars and sleeping on deck may be irresistible!

Our Private Semi-Luxury Dahabiya will accommodate us for 03 nights down the Nile towards the city of Esan (30 Miles before Luxor), while enjoying the mysterious Nile River; the longest river in the world. This is a great opportunity to kick-back and watch life on the banks of the Nile going by. Our meals start with lunch, a mixture of delicious local & international dishes & cuisines served onboard. There are 2 stops at Kom-Ombo and Edfu,. Do not miss the Egyptian Night Party (Galabiya Party where everyone onboard including the staff will dress in traditional costumes).





Day 5 Thu, 2nd May.

Sailing / Silsila / Edfu City. Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner Included

- Breakfast on board whilst sailing down the Nile
- Lunch included on the boat
- Visit local farmers and fishermen on a small Island. This will be the time to give small gifts like candy to the local children
- Continue Sailing and dock for an overnight in one of the Island
- In the evening there will be a barbecue, music and singing and a "Galabeya" party, where everyone dresses up in traditional Egyptian costumes for dinner

Gnosis of the Temple of Edfu & Temple of Horus

The temple was dedicated to the god Horus and was believed to be a place of healing and protection. It is believed that the temple was a place of pilgrimage for many people seeking spiritual guidance. Its walls were adorned with intricate hieroglyphs and sculptures depicting scenes from Egyptian mythology. This temple holds the Atlantean energy. Edfu Temple is one of the most striking and complete of ancient Egyptian temples and is dedicated to the worship of the god Horus.

- We will make a quick stop at a local stone cutter factory (Alabaster Shop) to watch how the ancient cut and sculpted their monuments and explore the ancient imitation of antique or replicas with alabaster & basalt plus granite statues

Gnosis on Temple of Hatshepsut & Valley of the Kings

The Temple of Hatshepsut is not only a memorial temple that honors Queen
Hatshepsut, it is also one of the greatest Egyptian architectural achievements. The temple's unique and beautiful design stands out from other ancient Egyptian temples. It is built into a cliff face and has a series of terraces leading up to the main entrance. The walls are decorated with reliefs depicting scenes from Queen Hatshepsut's life and reign and images of gods and goddesses. Hatshepsut, female king of Egypt (reigned in her own right c. 1473–58 bce) who attained unprecedented power for a woman, adopting the full titles and regalia of a pharaoh. At either end of the second level colonnade were two temples: The Temple of Anubis to the north and The Temple of Hathor to the south. As a woman in a position of power, Hatshepsut had a special relationship with the goddess Hathor and invoked her often. A temple to Anubis, the guardian and guide to the dead, was a common feature of any mortuary complex; one would not wish to slight the god who was responsible for leading one's soul from the tomb to the afterlife.

Our Journey:

This is a journey of empowerment, as an embodiment of how you wish to be seen in the world. How will you choose to show up. Hatshepsut was a female king showing inner strength and power from within.











Day 8

Sun, 5th May. Karnak Temple (Private Visit), Luxor temple Breakfast & Dinner Included

- Early Morning around 3 am, we will depart the hotel for our private visit to Sekhmet's chapel in the Karnak Temple, where we will have our morning circle
- We will walk through the seven doors into Sekhmet's Temple and experience the magnificent energies of healing and activation that she offers
- Breakfast at the hotel & rest

- In the afternoon, we will wonder and explore Luxor's famous site (Luxor Temple), which is also associated with the Third Chakra.
- Shopping In Luxor. You will also have a chance to explore the world of precious stones like Lapis & Turquoise and visit the famous jeweler shops in Luxor where you can get Egyptian Gold cartouches with your name in Hieroglyphic.

The temple of Karnak describes the process of the creation of the manifest universe, the descent of spirit into matter using the Golden Blueprint of Creation. The essence of Karnak temple comes most alive in a small sanctuary dedicated to Sekhmet the lioness goddess of healing and war. The massive 134 pillars of the Temple of Karnak is the representation of our Solar Plexus chakra/

In the ancient world the tradition called The Masters of the Net, is an illustration from the temple walls at Karnak, showing Thoth, the Ibis headed God, who stands behind the Egyptian high culture, stretching a cord, to give the extent of spirit moving in to physical space. While the Masters of the Net was one expression of the type of initiation that took place in great spiritual systems, to teach initiates how spiritual forces can be brought into manifestation in the physical world, this net that is being described is the same thing that we find in modern physics as The Net of Space Time.

Mon, 6th May Dendera Temple, Breakfast & Dinner Included


- After Breakfast at 09.00 we will drive north of the Nile to Explore the most beautiful temples on the Nile
